

Actual Painted Bar Stables Cost for Full Board

Here is a breakdown of the basic costs of keeping your horse at Painted Bar Stables. This includes the cost of services provided as well as additional costs that boarders may choose to provide in addition.

Feed

- One half bale of hay \$1.75 per day
 - *Six month supply of loose mineral supplement* \$25.00 or 0.07 per day
 - *Salt block* \$14.00 or \$0.04 per day
 - Two x eight cup (Two x one scoop) servings of inexpensive grain per day \$0.50 per day
- TOTAL OPTIONAL COST FOR FEED = \$0.11 per day*

Bedding

- 8 bags of bedding per month at \$4/bag \$1.07 per day

Labor

- 18 minutes of stable hand services per day at \$7.50/hour \$2.14 per day
- 10 minutes of stable owner services per day at \$15.00/hour \$2.50 per day
- 2 people for 6 hours delivering hay per month at \$7.50/hour divided by # horses.... \$0.11 per day
- 5 hours picking up grain per month at \$7.50/hour divided by # horses \$0.05 per day
- 10 hours of accounting & office work per month at \$7.50/hour divided by # horses \$0.09 per day

Utilities

- Insurance divided by # horses..... \$0.57 per day
- Property Taxes divided by # horses \$0.72 per day
- 20 gallons of water per day \$0.06 per day
- Electricity for lights, water heaters and fans \$0.12 per day
- Trash removal divided by # horses \$0.02 per day
- Fuel to pick up supplies divided by # horses..... \$0.15 per day

Repairs

- Water Bucket bi-yearly replacement \$0.02 per day
- Fencing and Stable Repairs \$0.36 per day
- Stall and Stable Supplies \$0.25 per day

Veterinary

- *Farrier every six week at* \$25 per trim or \$0.60 day
 - *Dewormer every 3 months* \$0.20 per day
 - *Dentistry once a year at* \$75 or \$0.20 per day
 - *Annual basic vaccinations* \$95.00 per year or \$0.27 per day
- rabies, tetanus, equine influenza, and other routine vaccines*

TOTAL OPTIONAL COST FOR VET = \$1.27 per day

Minimum Cost as Posted Online

Here is a breakdown of the basic **minimum** costs assuming you are keeping your horse or pony on your own property. These costs do not reflect the value of the property, land taxes, insurance, or property maintenance including barns and fences. The price of feed and professional services varies from one region to another so these costs will need to be adjusted for your area.

- One half bale of hay \$1.50 per day
 - Six month supply of loose mineral supplement \$25.00 or 0.07 per day
 - Salt block \$14.00 or \$0.04 per day
 - Two two cup servings of inexpensive grain per day \$1.00 per day
 - Farrier every six week at \$25 per trim or \$0.60 day
 - Dewormer every 3 months \$0.20 per day
 - Dentistry once a year at \$75 or \$0.20 per day
 - Annual basic vaccinations \$95.00 per year or \$0.27 per day
rabies, tetanus, equine influenza, and other routine vaccines
- \$3.68 per day
\$25.76 per week
\$110.40 per month
